

Special Use Procedures for Pistol

(These procedures maybe modified at anytime by the Range Committee with Board Approval)

In order to get a special use for pistol a member must –

1. Qualify with the Pistol Rangemaster during public shooting hours and receive a signed Qualification Card. Qualifying means-
 - Shoot a score of 60 with 10 shots on standard B-17 target.
 - All 10 shots must strike the target.
 - You must also display safe pistol handling while qualifying.
2. Must attend Range Committee, with your qualification card, participate in special use orientation for pistol, and have your request approved by the committee.

Member must qualify with the largest caliber pistol they want to shoot and the most difficult shooting style they plan to use. A member will only be approved for the caliber they qualified with or a smaller caliber. A person qualifying with a 44 or 45 may shoot all pistol calibers, whereas someone qualifying with a .22LR will be restricted to using only a .22LR.

Shooting styles allowed are

1. From a rest;
2. Two handed; and
3. One handed.

From the rest is considered the least difficult and one handed is considered the most difficult. If you qualify from a rest then you may only shoot from a rest; if you qualify two handed then you may only shoot two handed or from a rest, if you qualify one handed then you may shoot any allowed style. After you qualify and are approved by the Range Committee, a new badge will be issued. Until you receive your new badge you are restricted your previously approved current year permissions or none at all.

Members must request pistol special use for 3 consecutive years and again at the 10 year mark. Members may upgrade their pistol special use caliber or shooting style any time by re-qualifying, as stated above, to change the caliber and/or shooting style.

When preparing your special use request, only check those items that you already know how to do. This is required because you will be shooting without the supervision of a Rangemaster. You must be prepared to function as the Acting Rangemaster.
